### **Year 11 Mock Examinations - Ebacc subjects**

I am writing to let you know about the forthcoming Year 11 mock examinations. During the period between Wednesday 6th March to Friday 15th March 2023, your child will be sitting their second series of internal mock GCSE exams. The exams will be based around Ebacc subjects and will provide students with another opportunity to practise exam papers and learn from the experience in preparation for their actual GCSEs in summer.
